CAMPGROUND FAQs

Do you accept reservations?

No, our sites are strictly first-come, first-served.

What is the cost per night?

The cost is \$13/site for Stow residents and \$15/site for non-residents per night, and you may have up to six people per campsite.

What if we get there and there aren't any campsites available?

We recommend that you have a Plan B in place before you arrive. We tend to fill up on holiday weekends (and the days leading up to them), as well as other times during the season.

How close is Blossom Music Center and Cuyahoga Valley National Park?

They are both within 15-20 minutes from the campground (with no traffic.) Akron, Cleveland, Canton, Youngstown, and Medina are less than one hour away.

What size trailer can you accommodate? The maximum legal limit is 35-feet.

What electrical hookups do you have? We have 20-amp hook-ups, but they are a "strong" 20 amps.

Do you have water hook-ups?

No, but there are several water spigots scattered around the campsites and you can fill up your tank on the way in. But no permanent hook-ups are permitted.

Do you have showers?

No, but at the ball fields we have flush restrooms and sinks with hot & cold water.

What form(s) of payment do you accept?

Payment by cash or check ONLY.

How long can I stay at Silver Springs Campground?

We have a 5-night limit per campsite, and a 15-night limit within a 30-day period.

Is beer permitted?

No. Possession and/or consumption of alcohol is illegal in the Stow Park system.

A group of my friends (all teens) would like to have a campout. Is this OK, as long as at least one of us is 18 or older? No. In this situation, each camper must be 18 or older (with proper ID for verification).

Is it OK to bring our own firewood?

Yes, but we also have it for sale if needed. Cost for firewood is \$5/bundle.

Can we set up camp anytime during the day? What if we need to leave?

Yes, so long as you get registered before the 10 PM deadline. But you must register on the first night.

Can we go night-fishing?

No. Because our park system closes at dusk (when security lights come on), there's no night-fishing, flashlight tag, night-hikes, etc.

Is there a "Quiet Hour"? Yes, starting at 10 PM.

Can I have visitors?

Yes, until 10 PM.

When is check-out time?

Our check-out time is later than most...4 PM. After that, one extra night's fee will be charged.

Do you allow tents? How many can we have on a campsite?

Yes, and you may have up to 200 sq. ft. of floor space on your site.

Is it OK to feed the animals?

No, but it's OK (and even encouraged) to feed the Campground Attendant.
