Open seasonally from March 15 through December 1 each year, weather permitting.

Stow's dog park officially opened in June 2007, and has been well received by residents of Stow and the surrounding area. The park is owned by the City of Stow and managed by the Parks and Recreation Department.

The park is not staffed during open hours. It is incumbent upon park users to follow the clearly defined rules. The park features the following amenities:

- 7.5 acre fenced in park
- Sandy beach and grassy knolls
- 3-acre lake (NOT for human swimming)
- Separate entrance and exit
- Waste deposit stations
- Dog washing stations
- Separate area for small dogs
- Clearly defined rules and procedures





## Rules for Beach Visitors

For the safety of every dog that is brought to Bow Wow Beach by humans, and for the safety of all humans that bring their pets to the park, please adhere to the stated rules. Rules are in place to insure a peaceful yet playful experience for everyone and every dog!

Emergencies: Dial 911 immediately

- Park hours are 8am to dusk daily during the open season.
- Keep park gates closed at all times.
- Park visitors use the park at their own risk.
- No food of any kind is allowed in the park.
- Humans must stay out of the lake water.
- Humans must be at least 48" tall to enter the dog park.
- Puppies under four months of age are prohibited.
- Problem/aggressive dogs must be immediately removed.
- Leave unhealthy dogs or dogs in heat at home.
- Dogs with known history of dangerous behavior are prohibited.
- The facility will be closed when the lake is freezing or frozen.
- Large dogs are NOT permitted in the SMALL DOG area-small dogs ONLY! (Small dogs are 35 lbs. and under.)
- Dogs should be leashed when entering and leaving the park area.
- Quickly clean up after your dog, and dispose of the waste.
- No animals other than dogs are permitted in the dog park.
- Owners must carry leash and monitor dog's behavior at all times.
- Owners are responsible and liable for their dogs and children.
- Leaving dogs unattended is prohibited.
- Limit of three dogs per person.
- Dogs must wear a collar with identification at all times.
- No choke or pinch collars allowed in the park.
- All dogs must have current licenses and be current on immunizations and shots including rabies, distemper and parvovirus.
