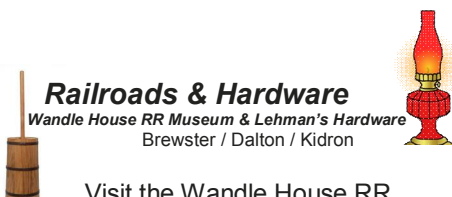




Akron Civic Theatre Back Stage Tour

Brewster / Dalton / Kidron

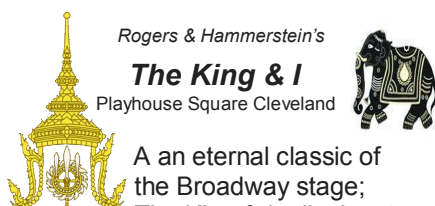

Bus Trips are open to all ages.

Children under 18 must be accompanied by an adult.

Pre-registration is required & full payment is due upon registration. No Holds

No credits or refunds are issued within 7 days of a program or trip due to change in personal schedule, illness or schedule conflict.

Refund requests may be granted if made in writing at least seven days prior to a trip or program only if no expenses/ticket purchases have occurred.

A \$5 processing fee is applied to all refunds made seven days prior to program. Individuals may always find a replacement for their reservation if unable to attend - Please inform the office of name change.

A full refund is given if the Stow Parks & Recreation Department must cancel a trip due to low enrollment or unforeseen circumstances.
